

PACKAGING AND LABELLING TEMPLATE ACCORDANCE WITH THE TOBACCO CONTROL ACT CHAP 30:04(TCA) AND THE TOBACCO CONTROL REGULATIONS (TCR) 2013 AND IT'S AMENDMENTS



PICTORIAL HEALTH WARNING

R.11 TCR:- Each carton shall depict any three health messages from Schedule 1 on all six sides, with each of the three health messages appearing on opposite sides of each other.

R.5(1) TCR:- The pictorial health messages shall be located on the lower half of the front and back panels of each pack.

R.5(3) TCR:- The pictorial health message shall cover half (50%) of the principal display surface area, front and back in a rectangular format.

R.5(4) TCR:- The pictorial health messages shall be -

- (a) printed on the pack in a framed area, with the thickness of the frame being not more than 0.5mm
- reproduced from electronic images obtained from and approved by the Tobacco Control Unit.



SCHEDULE 3 DECLARATION

R.7 TCR:- The declaration in Schedule 3 shall:

- (a) appear in a framed area-
 - On the side panel
 - On any side for cartons with the declaration area being at least 3cm by 9cm
- (b) be printed-
 - (i) on each pack or carton of tobacco products
 - in Avant Garde font, Medium BT, upper and lower case type or in an equivalent type with letters being 2mm high;
 - (iii) In black font on a yellow or white background.

Disclaimer: This design serves as a guide relative to the required information to be placed on the cigarette pack. Whilst the information and the placement of the Pictorial Health Warnings and the Schedule 3 Declaration are mandatory, other placements such as brand, manufacturer's information etc are only suggestive.

POINTS TO NOTE

S. 30 TCA Must be printed in English for Sale in Trinidad and Tobago

R. 4 TCR All information and health messages must be printed on pack or carton and not on packaging.

R.6 TCR

- (1) Pictorial health messages, in Set A and Set B which each contains 8 images that must be rotated in accordance with Schedule 2; and
- (2) must be evenly distributed in every case(container designed for transportation and storage of cartons in wholesale trade)

LABELLING INFORMATION

- S.28(2) TCA:- The following information shall be presented in a visible manner and shall be permanently affixed under the cellophane or other wrapping on all the sides of each tobacco product, package including each carton:
 - Name and licence number of the manufacturer as applicable wholesaler, importer and exporter
 - (b) Unique manufacturer serial number, date of manufacture and location
 - Name of country in which it was manufactured (c)
 - Name of country in which the product is intended

R.4(1)(d) TCR:- the name and address of the manufacturer

R.8 TCR:- manufacturing date and batch number



LIST OF CONSTITUENTS

S.25(1) TCA:- All tobacco products must contain permanently affixed a list of the constituents and additives namely Tar, Nicotine and Carbon Monoxide.



PRODUCT INFORMATION

R.4(1) TCR :- Shall be displayed on the surface areas:-

- (a) The type of tobacco product
- (b) Net contents or number of units per pack
